

A Helping Hand

San am direach tar éis na tubaiste, tháinig daonao ó gach cuid de phobal Kirkintilloch le chéile chun tacailocht a leírú. Chuir teaghlach áitiúla lóistín ar fáil do bheirt de na mná óga ón scuad prátaí. Cuireadh túis i dtairdeas atá fós le feiseáil sa lá atá inniu ann.

Ar an tráthnóna tar éis na tubaiste ag cruinníú de chuid Chomhairle Baile Kirkintilloch aontaifodh ciste poiblí faoiliúmhach a chur ar bun doilbh siud a thíange slán ón tubabiste agus a gclannadh agus gaolta na n-lopsacht. Tugadh €25 mar shintius "tosaigh". Chuir réimse leathan daóine éagsúla leis an gciste, ina measc, Benny Lynch, an dornáilai bhiodh ina churadh domhanda agus a bhiodh ag traenáil go háiltíúil, agus stírthóirí Chumann Peile na Gaeilgeach (Celtic).

Bhi ról lárnach ag an gcaptaen Robert Maguire, MC, JP, ann, diolodóir as Glaschú a bhíodh ina chóinéar ar Bhóthar Bellfield, Kirkintilloch. B'eisean an gniomhaire Albanach díl de chuid an OALH (AOH), Ord Ársa Lucht Hibernian (Ancient Order of Hibernians), cumann cairdíülí i Albain ag glac daoine de bhuadh Éireannach páirt ann do chuid ba mhó, agus páróisteach de chuid an Teaghlach Naofa agus Naomh Ninian. Tháinig sé go sealftanas do dtabharfadh séaire do leasa theaghlach Thíne Bothy agus gnádánfadh sé cíntte go rachadh na síntíús a tugadh don chiste faoisimh, ach go hárifíthe na síntíús sin a tháinig ó fhoinsí i nGlaschú, go slán sábháilte chuir Comhairle Baile Kirkintilloch.

In the immediate aftermath of the disaster, all sections of the Kirkintilloch community rallied round to provide support. Two of the young women from the potato squad were accommodated by local families. Friendships were formed that have survived down to the present time.

On the evening after the disaster, at a meeting of Kirkintilloch Town Council, it was agreed to open a public relief fund for the survivors and families and relatives of the victims, and £25 was contributed as a 'starter' donation. A very wide range of different people contributed to the fund, including Benny Lynch, the world champion boxer, who trained locally, and the directors of Celtic Football Club.

A major part was played by Captain Robert Maguire JP, a Glasgow solicitor who resided in Bellfield Road, Kirkintilloch. He was the Scottish law agent of the AOH (Ancient Order of Hibernians) and a Holy Family & St Ninian's parishioner. He made a commitment to attend to the interests of the Bothy Fire families and made sure that donations to the relief fund, especially those from Glasgow sources, were safely transmitted to Kirkintilloch Town Council.



Chaidh dithis as na boireannach òga bho sguaid a bhuntata a thoirt a-steach le teaghlaichnean san nàbaidheachd. Chaidh cairdeas a chruthachadh aig an àm sin a tha air maireachdainn gus an latha an-dliugh.

Bhà raon farsaing de dhiofar dhaoine a' cur a-steach dham mhaoin, nam measg Benny O Loingsigh, fear-sabhalod is clonnachair air an tsaothal, ag bhioidh a' treanaingeadh sa choimhlearsnachd ionadail agus lùgh-dìstrìubh Club Ball-coise Celtic.

Fhuair eachdha taic sónraichteach bhon Chaippean Raibeart MacGuire, Maor Ceartais, fear-lagha ann an Glaschu a bha a' fuirreach air Rathad Bhaile an Achaidh ann an Kirkintilloch. B'e esan an aildseant lagha a bha aig Óruadh Ársaídh nam Eireannach ann an Alba, comann cárdeil a bha gu mòr air a chealachdadh le daoine ann an Alba aig an robh buntanas ri Ériinn, agus bha e na pharaisceach de dh' Eaglais an Teaghlach Naoimh & An Naoimh Ninein. Chuir e roimhe gnothaichean a bha a' beartainn do theaghlachian co-cheangaladh ri Teine na Bothaig a ghabhail os láimh, agus rinn e cinteach gun robh tabhartasan dha mhaoin choibhre, gu h-áráid feadhainn a bha a' tighinn i Glaschu, gan cur gu sábhailte gu Comhairle Baile Kirkintilloch.
