

Lion Foundry castings could be found across the United Kingdom from Portsmouth, Bangor and the Isle of Man to Belfast and Banff but the Lion also built up an international reputation. Castings were shipped from Kirkintilloch to locations across the world. For example the firm produced twelve gates and around six thousand feet of ornamental railings for a Prince's residence in Bombay, several porticos for Indian Banks, and the railings for Calcutta race course.

Building front panels were supplied for the Customs House in Shanghai and a government building in Hong Kong, while a massive 60 ft wide by 43 ft high window surround was manufactured for the Buenos Aires Great Southern Railway in Argentina. Because of their reputation for high quality iron work the Lion-Foundry made a significant contribution not only to the built peritage of the United Kingdom but also the wider world.
